## Background information for November meeting

The Pan-Islington Patient Group: Islington health commissioners the Clinical Commissioning Group have set this group up to share information with local residents, and to hear their views. This information will mainly be around service design and quality. Some people have suggested we change the name of this group to make it more attractive to potential new members, if you have a suggestion, let us know.

The Clinical Commissioning Group: Islington Clinical Commissioning Groups is made up of 34 GP practices across the borough, and they are responsible for commissioning around £300 million of healthcare services for the people of Islington. They work closely with our local council, with patients and service users, and with service providers to get the best possible services for those in our community.

**Healthwatch Islington:** Healthwatch Islington is set up to gather community feedback on health and care services. We have been commissioned by Islington Clinical Commissioning Group to support the patient group. We are working with partners **Every Voice** and **Manor Gardens Health Advocacy Project** to increase the reach of the group.

How services are planned across North Central London: The Clinical Commissioning groups in North Central London boroughs of Barnet, Camden, Enfield, Haringey and Islington are working together to deliver health services. NHS England requires them to develop a Sustainability and Transformation Plan to demonstrate how they will do this going forward. There is already some work taking place across this area, for example, the recent commissioning of urgent care and the 111 service. Commissioners will maintain an Islington focus.

The CCGs talk to residents about how to improve services and access to services and these conversations will continue.

A reminder from the last meeting

Increased access to GP services: Islington registered patients can now access a GP 7 days a week from 8:00am to 8:00pm through 'hubs' located across the borough. Call your regular practice to be booked in.
