Hyperlinks – a link from a text document to another location. Internet - system of connected computers around the world that allows people to share information.

Operating System – the software that supports a computer's basic functions, such as Windows or iOS.

Search engine – a website where you can search for and locate keywords on other websites.

Website - a page(s) of information on the internet about a particular subject.
